What is Medication Assisted Therapy?

FDA-approved medications are administered along with other therapies to manage withdrawal symptoms.



Who Can Get Treatment?

Native and non-native, over the age of eighteen who are diagnosed with a moderate to severe Opioid Use Disorder (OUD).



How Does Admission Work?

A behavioral health screening initiates the admission process, collaborating with other treatment and healthcare providers.
